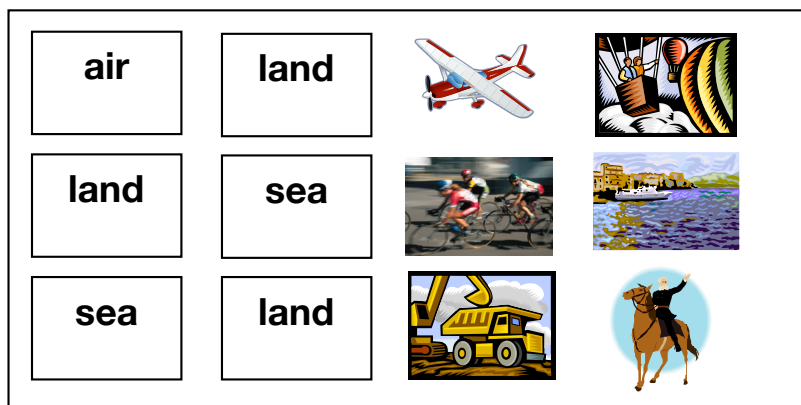


VOCABULARY AND CATEGORISATION



ACTIVITY NAME: TWO WAY CONCENTRATION

Purpose

This activity is used to practise matching the name of transport forms to the correct photo or sorting forms of transport and where it travels - land, water or air. It is used for building basic transport vocabulary.

Strategies

You may wish to consider teacher think alouds, vocabulary expansion, soliciting background knowledge, visual cue use and think time during the lesson.

Resources

Two category match cards - cut out and placed in a zip lock bag

Instructions

1. Have the class discuss different forms of transport and where they travel. Not all students will have the required vocabulary or knowledge. Explicitly teach needed concepts.
2. Model and explain how to play memory concentration.
3. Students remove the cards from the bag. Place all cards upside down. Students turn over two cards when it is their turn and read the word aloud. When they find the picture and matching word the student wins the cards and has a second turn. If the cards do not match, the student turns the cards back over.
4. After all pairs have been matched, the student with the most cards is the winner.
