ACTIVITY NAME - TWO WAY MATCH

Purpose

Development and consolidation of naming vocabulary.

Strategies

You may wish to consider teacher think alouds, vocabulary expansion, visual cue use and think time during the lesson.

Resources

- Concentration game (pictures and words laminated & cut out) for each pair of students. Colour code the picture cards from the word cards by using backing laminate of different colours
- Larger teacher copy of the game for modelling and instruction

Game 1 Instructions

1. Explicitly teach the name of each animal in oral and written form.
2. Explain and model the concentration game.
3. Provide each pair of students with a two-way match card game.
4. To begin with, pictures and cards remain up turned. Students match words and pictures.

Game 2 Instructions – Concentration

1. Pictures and word cards are mixed up and turned down.
2. Each player turns a picture card and a word card up. When the player turns up a matching pair they say a sentence relating to the animal and get an extra turn.
3. Play continues until all the picture and word cards are matched.
